

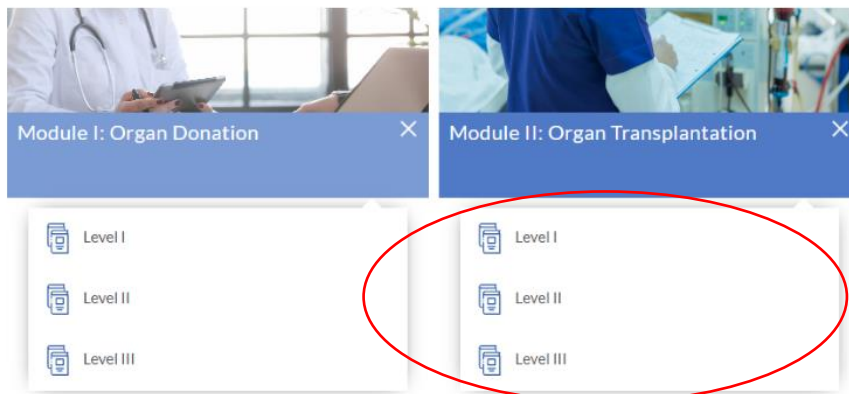

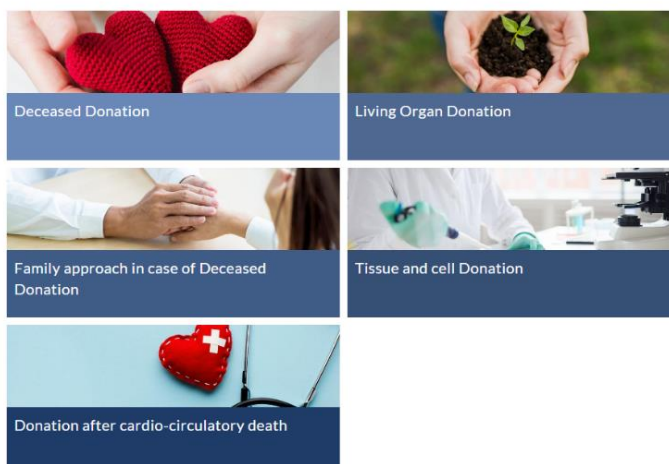

LEVEL II

When you choose to access the **Level II**, you will see all the different self-learning topics corresponding to organ donation. The first steps to do are privacy compliance and the pre-test. The results will be later compared with the final test. Each topic contains theoretical content to read and self-assessment activity. To be able to access the next topic for the participant, they need to pass this activity on a minimum of 80%. After finishing all the topics, the participant needs to pass the Final Evaluation Test and submit the feedback.
